Being the youngest of a set of triplets in a family of seven siblings growing up in a deprived hill sheep farm in Devon, Lucy set out to explore her place in the world away from Devon in search of her identity. Ironically, she has come full circle by embracing her past and finding her voice with wool as her primary artistic material where she carefully selects and transforms this organic material into richly layered creations that capture a sense of movement and life. Her art reflects a deep respect for nature and a commitment to sustainable, mindful practices.
